PURSUANT to section 41 of the Surveyors Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Surveyors Professional Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Surveyors Professional Regulations 1977* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1985.

°S.R. 1977/290 Amendment No. 1: S.R. 1981/278 2. Fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 36 (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Surveyors Professional Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the following regulation:

"36. The following fees shall be payable to the Board-	\$
"(a) Accompanying an application for registration as a surveyor	
under the Act	40
"(b) For the issue of a certificate of registration as a surveyor	15
"(c) For the restoration of a name to the register	35
"(d) For the issue of a letter of accreditation	20
"(e) For an application to sit the written examination specified	
in regulation 6 (1) of these regulations	30
"(f) For an application for a review of an examination under	
regulation 16 of these regulations	15
"(g) For an application to sit the professional interview	
examination conducted under regulation 7 of these	
regulations	100."

3. Consequential revocation—The Surveyors Professional Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 1 are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect. These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 1985, increase the fees payable under the Surveyors Professional Regulations 1977.
