**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 10th day of June 1985

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. DAVID LANGE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 41 of the Surveyors Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Surveyors Professional Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Surveyors Professional Regulations 1977\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1985.

**2. Fees**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 36 (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Surveyors Professional Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the following regulation:

“36. The following fees shall be payable to the Board—	\$
“(a) Accompanying an application for registration as a surveyor under the Act .. .. .	40
“(b) For the issue of a certificate of registration as a surveyor	15
“(c) For the restoration of a name to the register .. .. .	35
“(d) For the issue of a letter of accreditation .. .. .	20
“(e) For an application to sit the written examination specified in regulation 6 (1) of these regulations .. .. .	30
“(f) For an application for a review of an examination under regulation 16 of these regulations .. .. .	15
“(g) For an application to sit the professional interview examination conducted under regulation 7 of these regulations .. .. .	100.”

**3. Consequential revocation**—The Surveyors Professional Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 1 are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 1985, increase the fees payable under the Surveyors Professional Regulations 1977.
