PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Sea-fisheries Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 11.
2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Sea-fisheries Regulations 1939* and the amendments thereof.
3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification thereof in the *Gazette*.
4. Regulation 4 of the Sea-fisheries Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 10, relating to crayfish, is revoked.
