



## THE SEA-FISHERIES REGULATIONS 1939, AMENDMENT NO. 1.

GALWAY, Governor-General.

### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 20th day of December, 1939.

Present :

THE HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Sea-fisheries Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Sea-fisheries Regulations 1939\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification thereof in the *Gazette*.

4. Regulation 8 of Part I of the principal regulations is revoked, and the following regulation substituted :—

“ 8. No person shall take, buy, sell, expose for sale, or have in possession any fish of any of the species enumerated in this regulation of a less size than that set opposite the name of such fish :—

† † Of a less length than 2 ft. measured from the snout to the tip of the tail, or having a length without head, of less than 15 in. measured from the back side of the base of the pectoral fin to the tip of the tail.

‡ ‡ Measured from the tip of the nose to the posterior end of the middle ray of the tail fin (i.e., to the angle of the V or the centre of the concave edge between the flukes of the tail).”
