THE SEA-FISHERIES REGULATIONS 1939, AMENDMENT NO. 4.

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 12th day of June, 1940.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Sea-fisheries Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 4.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Sea-fisheries Regulations 1939* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations) and the amendments thereof.

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1940.

4. Regulation 2 of Part XIV of the principal regulations is revoked, and the following regulation substituted :—

“ 2. The months of October, November, December, January, and the first fourteen days of February in each year are hereby prescribed as a close season for the taking of oysters in the waters of Foveaux Strait and in the tidal waters of the South Island and Stewart Island and the islands adjacent to Foveaux Strait. During such close season it shall be unlawful for any person to take oysters :

“ Provided, first, that during the period from the first day to the fifteenth day of October in each year it shall be lawful for any person to be in possession of any such oysters lawfully taken during the open season in that year :

“ Provided, secondly, that during the year 1940 the last sixteen days of the month of October and the months of November and December in that year and the month of January and the first fourteen days of February in the year 1941 are hereby prescribed as a close season for the taking of oysters in the said waters :

“ Provided, thirdly, that during the period from the sixteenth day to the thirty-first day of October in the year 1940 it shall be lawful for any person to be in possession of any oysters lawfully taken from the said waters during the open season for that year.”
