THE SEA-FISHERIES REGULATIONS 1939, AMENDMENT NO. 7.

GALWAY, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 9th day of October, 1940.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Sea-fisheries Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 7.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Sea-fisheries Regulations 1939* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations) and the amendments thereof.
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of November, 1940.
- **4.** The proviso to paragraph (f) of Regulation 2 of Part XVIII of the principal regulations is revoked, and the following proviso substituted:—
- "Provided that in respect of any area described in Regulation 13 of this part of these regulations the period in the year nineteen hundred and forty during which it shall be unlawful for the licensee of any such area to take toheroa therefrom shall be the months of November and December."
