**THE STOCK-REMEDIES REGULATIONS 1947,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

Present :

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Stock-remedies Act, 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Stock-remedies Regulations 1947, Amendment No. 1.
2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed to form part of the Stock-remedies Regulations 1947* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
3. These regulations shall come into force on the seventh day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.
4. Regulation 13 of the principal regulations (including the heading thereto) is revoked, and the following regulation substituted :—

Teat Salves

“13. Every preparation described by the proprietor as a teat salve or intended for sale for the treatment of sore teats of cows shall contain a recognized antiseptic in effective concentration. Such preparation shall not contain any substance capable of tainting milk.”

5. Clause (1) of Regulation 23 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking paragraphs (a), (b), and (c) thereof, and substituting the following paragraphs :—

“(a) On application by a proprietor for the initial registration of one stock-remedy in respect of one period of registration	£	s.	d.
