

THE SHIPPING (FEES) REGULATIONS 1962, AMENDMENT NO. 1

Pursuant to the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Shipping (Fees) Regulations 1962, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Shipping (Fees) Regulations 1962* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1966.
- 2. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from the heading to the fourth column of Part I of Section A the words "Twelve Months", and substituting the words "More than Six Months but not More than Twelve Months".
- 3. (1) The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby further amended by inserting in Part I of Section A, in the appropriate columns thereof, the following words:

accordance with paragraph (a) of this Part of this Schedule, with a minimum fee of £2."

(2) The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby further amended by inserting in the second column of Part I of Section A. after the words "paragraph (b)", the words "or paragraph (c)".

4. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby further amended by adding to Part VI of Section A, in the appropriate columns thereof, the following words:

| Exceeding 500 tons gross | 10 10 0"

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations make the following changes in the principal regulations:

(a) Provision is made for fees in the case of survey certificates and safety certificates which may be issued for periods of more than six months

but less than 12 months:

(b) Special fees are prescribed for the survey of ships arriving in New Zealand which are intended to be registered in New Zealand and have already been surveyed overseas:

(c) A fee is prescribed for submersion-line surveys of ships exceeding 500

tons gross.
