Present:

The Right Hon. R. D. Muldoon presiding in Council Pursuant to the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Shipping (Fees) Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Shipping (Fees) Regulations 1977* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Fees for engineers' certificates—The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking Section B, and substituting the following Section:
