PURSUANT to sections 501 and 504 of the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Shipping (Fees) Regulations 1990, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Shipping (Fees) Regulations 1990* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Fees—Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking so much of Section D of subclause (4) as relates to the items set out in paragraphs (c) to (k) of that Section.

3. First Schedule amended—The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking Part XI of Section D of that Schedule.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force 28 days after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, amend the Shipping (Fees) Regulations 1990 by revoking fees relating to ship registration. Such fees are now prescribed by the Ship Registration (Fees) Regulations 1992.
