PURSUANT to sections 501 and 504 of the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Shipping (Fees) Regulations 1990, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Shipping (Fees) Regulations 1990* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. New Second Schedule substituted—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule, and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
