ORDER IN COUNCIL

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 204 (2) and 445 of the Maritime Transport Act 1994, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Shipping (Fees) Regulations 1990, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Shipping (Fees) Regulations 1990* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. New Second Schedule substituted—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Shipping (Fees) Regulations 1990, Amendment No. 2), and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

3. Revocation—The Shipping (Fees) Regulations 1990, Amendment No. 2 are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force 28 days after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, amend the Shipping (Fees) Regulations 1990 by substituting new fees in respect of certain marine examinations, certificates, and licences.
