At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 19th day of December 1961

PURSUANT to the Samoa Act 1921, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Samoa Reserved Enactments Order 1961.

2. This order shall come into force on the date of the making thereof, and shall expire when the repeal of the Samoa Act 1921 by the Western Samoa Act 1961 comes into force.

3. The Civil Aviation Act 1948 is hereby declared not to be a reserved enactment for the purposes of section 32 of the Samoa Amendment Act 1957.
