Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Shipping Requisitioning Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 3.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Shipping Requisitioning Emergency Regulations 1939* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations (as heretofore amended) is amended by inserting therein, after the words "service of State", the words "or for any other purpose of the Government".
