



**THE SHIPPING REQUISITIONING EMERGENCY REGULATIONS
1939, AMENDMENT NO. 4.**

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 3rd day of
December, 1941.

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Shipping Requisitioning Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 4.

2. These regulations shall be read with and form part of the Shipping Requisitioning Emergency Regulations 1939* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is revoked, and the following substituted :—

“ 3. The Minister of Marine may delegate all or any of the powers conferred on him by these regulations to the Secretary for Marine (hereinafter referred to as the Secretary), and the exercise by the Secretary of any powers under these regulations shall be sufficient evidence that a delegation of those powers has been made and is in force.”

4. The principal regulations are amended by revoking the words “ Director of Sea Transport ” and the word “ Director ” wherever these words respectively occur, and substituting in each case the word “ Secretary ”.
