

## THE SHIPPING RESTRICTED LIMITS NOTICE 1953, AMENDMENT NO. 2

Pursuant to the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952, the Minister of Marine hereby gives the following notice.

## NOTICE

- 1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Shipping Restricted Limits Notice 1953, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Shipping Restricted Limits Notice 1953\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).
- (2) This notice shall come into force on the seventh day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. (1) The Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by inserting, after the reference to the Port of Bluff, the following words:

"Breaksea Sound | Inside a right line commencing at the and Dusky Sound | southernmost point on the northern | southernmost point on the northern side of the entrance to Breaksea Sound and extending southward to the easternmost point of the east-ernmost island of the Gilbert Islands ernmost island of the Gilbert Islands and continuing on in a straight line to the north-eastern side of Resolution Island; and inside a right line commencing at the westernmost point of Resolution Island opposite to the easternmost point of the Casternmost island of the Useless Isles in Dusky Sound and extending to the westernmost point of Fixed Head; thence in a right line to the westernmost point of Indian Island; thence in a right line to the north-westernmost point of the entrance to Pickersgill Harbour.

Inside a right line drawn from the westernmost point of Oliver Point in Breaksea Sound to the northernmost point of Breaksea Island and inside a right line drawn south from the westernmost point of Breaksea Island to the shore on Resolution Island, and inside a right line drawn from the southernmost line drawn from the southernmost point of Five Fingers Point, Reso-lution Island, to the northernmost point of South Point in Dusky point of Sound."

(2) The Schedule to the principal notice is hereby further amended by inserting in the first column, after the reference to the Ports of Dunedin and Port Chalmers, the words "Dusky Sound (see Breaksea Sound and Dusky Sound)".

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This notice prescribes river limits and extended river limits for the ports of Breaksea Sound and Dusky Sound.
