**THE SHIPPING RESTRICTED LIMITS NOTICE 1953,
AMENDMENT NO. 6**

—

PURSUANT to the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952, the Minister of Marine hereby gives the following notice.

—

NOTICE

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Shipping Restricted Limits Notice 1953, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Shipping Restricted Limits Notice 1953* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the seventh day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting so much of the second column as relates to the Port of Havelock, and substituting the following words:

“Inside right lines drawn from West Entry Point to the northernmost point of Forsyth Island and from Yellow Point in a direction 110° to the southern extremity of Alligator Head.”

3. The Schedule to the principal notice is hereby further amended by omitting so much of the third column as relates to the Port of Whangarei, and substituting the following words:

“Inside a right line drawn from Bream Head to Bream Tail.

“Special limits: For vessels engaged in carrying fishing parties only, duly equipped with radiotelephone as for deep-sea sports fishing and plying in fine weather and favourable conditions only:

“Within the area bounded by right lines drawn from Bream Head to a position 1 mile north-east of Maro Tiri light, thence to a position 2 miles south of the most easterly point of Taranga Island, and thence to the shore at Bream Tail.

“Seasonal: For vessels engaged in deep-sea sports fishing only, duly equipped with radiotelephone and plying in fine weather and favourable conditions only:

“In winter: Between Rimariki (Wide Berth Island) and Bream Tail and not more than 12 miles from the shore.

“In summer: Between Rimariki (Wide Berth Island) and Bream Tail and not more than 20 miles from the shore.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice prescribes new river limits for the Port of Havelock.

This notice also prescribes new extended river limits (other than seasonal limits) and also special limits for vessels carrying fishing parties, for the Port of Whangarei.

It also amends the provisions as to seasonal limits for the Port of Whangarei by inserting a condition that vessels engaged in deep-sea sports fishing must be equipped with radiotelephone and ply only in fine weather and favourable conditions.
