Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Stock Remedies Act 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Stock Remedies (Biological Products) Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Stock Remedies (Biological Products) Regulations 1951* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Regulation 39 of the principal regulations, as substituted by regulation 2 of the Stock Remedies (Biological Products) Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 2, is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from paragraph (c) of subclause (4) the words “Blackleg vaccine for the prevention of blackleg in cattle, and”:
- (b) By adding to paragraph (a) of subclause (5) the words “or cattle”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations remove the restriction requiring administration by a veterinarian of blackleg vaccine for cattle.
