Pursuant to the Stock Remedies Act 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Stock Remedies (Biological Products) Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Stock Remedies (Biological Products) Regulations 1951* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 4 of the Stock Remedies (Biological Products) Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 3, and amended by regulation 2 of the Stock Remedies (Biological Products) Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 6, and by regulation 2 of the Stock Remedies (Biological Products) Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 7) is hereby further amended by adding to clause 2 the following paragraphs:

"(i) Spiramycin in an injectable or soluble powder form (for the treatment of diseases in poultry):

"(j) Streptomycin sulphate (for use as a food supplement for poultry and for pigs up to three months, and for the treatment of diseases of poultry):

"(k) Bacitracin methylene disalicylate (for use as a food supplement for poultry and for pigs up to three months, and for the treatment of diseases of poultry):

"(1) Aureomycin soluble (for the treatment of diseases of poultry)."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations vary the schedule of substances to which, in accordance with regulation 40 of the principal regulations, restrictions on retail sale, dispensing, and prescribing apply.
