ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 12th day of May 1953

Present:

THE HON. K. J. HOLYOAKE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Stock Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Sheep Return Regulations 1953.

2. The return referred to in section 52 of the Stock Act 1908 shall be in the form set out in the First Schedule to these regulations:

Provided that in the year 1957 and in every fifth year thereafter the return shall be in the form set out in the Second Schedule to these regulations.

3. The Sheep Return Regulations 1951\* are hereby revoked.
