## THE SUPERANNUATION (SAMOAN ADJUSTMENT ALLOWANCE) ORDER 1967

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Superannuation Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

## ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Superannuation (Samoan Adjustment Allowance) Order 1967.

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of May 1958.

2. In this order,—

- "Adjustment allowance" means an allowance which is granted to a person employed in the Western Samoan Public Service who is also permanently employed in the New Zealand Government Service or is a supernumerary employee of that Service for the purpose of increasing the salary paid to that person to the approximate level of the salary paid in New Zealand for performance of comparable duties there:
- The terms "New Zealand Government Service", "Western Samoan Public Service" and "supernumerary employee of the New Zealand Government Service" have the same meanings as in section 9 of the Finance Act 1961.

3. It is hereby declared that the adjustment allowance, which is paid in respect of any period after the commencement of this order to any person who makes an election in accordance with the proviso to subsection (5) of section 9 of the Finance Act 1961, shall be deemed to be salary for the purposes of Part II of the Superannuation Act 1956.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order is made under section 56 of the Superannuation Act 1956, and provides that the Samoan adjustment allowance payable in respect of any period after the beginning of May 1958 to any person who makes an election in accordance with the proviso to section 9 (5) of the Finance Act 1961 shall be deemed to be salary for the purposes of Part II of the Superannuation Act 1956.
