PURSUANT to sections 116, 123 (2), and 132 of the Social Security Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title, commencement, and application—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Wigs and Hairpieces) Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Social Security (Wigs and Hairpieces) Regulations 1981* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 15th day of October 1990, and shall apply to wigs and hairpieces benefits provided on or after

that date.

- 2. Increased benefits as from 15 October 1990—Regulation 3 of the principal regulations (as amended by the Social Security (Wigs and Hairpieces) Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 2) is hereby amended—
 - (a) By omitting from paragraph (a) of subclause (1) the expression "\$330", and substituting the expression "\$400":
 - (b) By omitting from paragraph (b) of subclause (1) the expression "\$93.50", and substituting the expression "\$180":
 - (c) By omitting from paragraph (c) of subclause (1) the expression "\$330", and substituting the expression "\$400":
 - (d) By omitting from paragraph (a) of subclause (2) the expression "\$330", and substituting the expression "\$400".
- **3. Revocation**—Regulation 3 of the Social Security (Wigs and Hairpieces) Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 2 is hereby consequentially revoked.
