

THE SERVICEMEN'S SETTLEMENT AND LAND SALES REGULATIONS 1943, AMENDMENT NO. 2

At the Government House at Wellington, this 18th day of December, 1946

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Servicemen's Settlement and Land Sales Act, 1943, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Servicemen's Settlement and Land Sales Regulations 1943, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Servicemen's Settlement and Land Sales Regulations 1943* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of

January, 1947.

2. On and from the date upon which these regulations come into force the principal regulations shall be read as if there were added to each of the forms of declarations appended to form No. 2, form No. 3, and form No. 4 respectively, prescribed in the Schedule to the principal

regulations, the following paragraph:

"5. That, with the exception of agreements referred to in paragraph 3 hereof, no contract or agreement (whether in writing or otherwise) within the meaning of section 8 of the Servicemen's Settlement and Land Sales Amendment Act, 1946, for the sale, transfer, hiring, or delivery of any personal property, or for execution of any works or the erection of any building, or for the granting of an option in relation to any such matter, has been entered into by me or by my wife [husband] or by any company of which I or my wife [husband] or both my wife [husband] and I are members and as such entitled to a majority of votes at general meetings of such company; and that no such contract or agreement is intended to be entered into."
