



**THE SOCIAL SECURITY (RURAL AREA) NOTICE 1969,
AMENDMENT NO. 3**

PURSUANT to section 94A of the Social Security Act 1964, the Minister of Health hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Social Security (Rural Area) Notice 1969, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Social Security (Rural Area) Notice 1969* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of November 1971.

2. Clause 3 of the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (o) the word "Rangiora,".
