**THE SOCIAL SECURITY (RURAL AREA) NOTICE 1969,
AMENDMENT NO. 4**

PURSUANT to section 94A of the Social Security Act 1964, the Minister of Health hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Social Security (Rural Area) Notice 1969, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Social Security (Rural Area) Notice 1969* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1978.

2. Kaiapoi Borough declared rural area—Clause 3 (o) of the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting the words “boroughs of Kaiapoi, or Riccarton”, and substituting the words “borough of Riccarton”.
