**THE SECONDARY SCHOOL BOARDS ADMINISTRATION AND
EMPLOYMENT REGULATIONS 1965, AMENDMENT NO. 5**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 8th day of November 1976

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Secondary School Boards Administration and Employment Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Secondary Boards Administration and Employment Regulations 1965* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Appointment of members by Proprietors of integrated schools—The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 6, the following regulation:

“6A. Every member representing the proprietors of an integrated school shall be appointed by delivery to the Board of a notice in writing executed by the Proprietors of that school so appointing him, in the case of a regular triennial appointment before the day on which the member so appointed is to assume office but not more than 3 months before that day, and in the case of a casual vacancy within 50 days after the fact of the vacancy has been notified to the Proprietors.”

3. Qualification of members—The principal regulations are hereby further amended by adding to regulation 14, as subclause (2), the following subclause:

“(2) A person eligible in terms of these regulations to be a member of a Board shall be eligible to be appointed to a Board of an integrated school by the Proprietors of that school.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the principal regulations to allow for the appointment to the governing bodies of integrated secondary schools of members representing the Proprietors of integrated schools.
