ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 29th day of June 1981

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

---

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Secondary School Boards Administration and Employment Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 9, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Secondary School Boards Administration and Employment Regulations 1965\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Secondary school teacher may be directed to undertake duties in attached intermediate department**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 59, the following regulation:

“59AA. To the extent that, in the opinion of the Principal of a secondary school to which there is attached an intermediate department, by reason of—

- “(a) An absence of teachers; or
- “(b) An emergency; or
- “(c) The special qualifications and experience in the area of the curriculum of that department of any assistant teacher employed in that school,—

it is desirable for an assistant teacher employed in that school (or, as the case requires, that teacher) to carry out any teaching or supervisory duties in that department, he may direct that assistant teacher to undertake those duties; and in that case that teacher shall undertake those duties accordingly.”

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations provide for an assistant teacher employed in a secondary school to which there is attached an intermediate department to undertake duties in that department if the Principal directs him to do so.
