

THE SOCIAL SECURITY (HOSPITAL BENEFITS FOR OUT-PATIENTS) REGULATIONS 1941, AMENDMENT NO. 1

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Social Security Act, 1938, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Hospital Benefits for Out-patients) Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Social Security (Hospital Benefits for Out-patients) Regulations 1941* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) Hospital treatment, as defined by the principal regulations, may, with the approval of the Minister, be afforded to out-patients

elsewhere than at a public hospital.

(2) The approval of the Minister for the purposes of this clause may be given to all Hospital Boards or to any specified Hospital Board, and may apply with respect to all patients suffering from any specified ailment or bodily condition, or may be limited to specified patients or to patients of a specified class.

(3) Any approval under this clause may be given subject to such

conditions as the Minister thinks fit to impose.

(4) Except in respect of treatment afforded in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this clause, no payment out of the Social Security Fund shall be made in respect of any hospital treatment that is afforded after the commencement of these regulations to any outpatient elsewhere than at a public hospital.

(5) Clause 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (b) of the definition of the term "hospital

treatment", the words "at the hospital".
