PURSUANT to the Social Security Act, 1938, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Hospital Benefits for Outpatients) Regulations 1947, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Social Security (Hospital Benefits for Outpatients) Regulations 1947\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting in subclause (1), after the word "supply", the words "or repair," and also by inserting after the words "such aids", the words "or the repair thereof".
