PURSUANT to the Social Security Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

## ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Social Security (Immunisation Benefit) Order 1976.

2. Application of order—This order shall apply in respect of vaccine administered on or after the 1st day of October 1975.

3. Fees—The following fees are hereby fixed in respect of each occasion on which vaccine is administered by a medical practitioner, or by a registered general nurse acting under the direction of a medical practitioner, pursuant to section 97A (1) of the Social Security Act 1964:

- (a) A fee of \$1.85 if the vaccine is administered by the medical practitioner or under the direct supervision of the medical practitioner:
- (b) A fee of \$1.55 in any other case.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order fixes a new scale of fees payable to medical practitioners by the Department of Health in respect of immunisation services carried out under section 97A of the Social Security Act 1964. The order applies in respect of vaccine administered on or after 1 October 1975.
