**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 27th day of October 1981

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Social Security Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

---

**ORDER**

**1. Title**—This order may be cited as the Social Security (Immunisation Benefit) Order 1981.

**2. Application of order**—This order shall apply in respect of vaccine administered on or after the 1st day of September 1981.

**3. Fee**—A fee of \$4 is hereby fixed in respect of each occasion on which vaccine is administered by a medical practitioner, or by a registered general nurse acting under the direction of a medical practitioner, pursuant to section 97A (1) of the Social Security Act 1964.

**4. Revocation**—The Social Security (Immunisation Benefit) Order 1978\* is hereby revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order increases the immunisation benefit from \$2.25 to \$4 in respect of vaccine administered on or after 1 September 1981.
