ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 5th day of August 1985

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL
PURSUANT to the Social Security Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the Social Security (Immunisation Benefit) Order 1985.
- 2. Application of order—This order shall apply in respect of vaccine administered on or after the 1st day of August 1985. In respect of vaccine administered before that date, the order referred to in clause 4 of this order shall continue to apply as if this order had not been made.
- **3. Fee**—A fee of \$7 is hereby fixed in respect of each occasion on which vaccine is administered by a medical practitioner, or by a registered general nurse acting under the direction of a medical practitioner, pursuant to section 97A (1) of the Social Security Act 1964.

4. Revocation—The Social Security (Immunisation Benefit) Order 1981* is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order increases the immunisation benefit from \$4 to \$7 in respect of vaccine administered on or after 1 August 1985.
