# THE SOCIAL SECURITY (MONETARY BENEFITS) REGULATIONS 1939, AMENDMENT NO. 2

Pursuant to the Social Security Act 1938, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Monetary Benefits) Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Social Security (Monetary Benefits) Regulations 1939\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 6, and substituting the following regulation:
- "6. Any declaration that may be required for the purposes of Part II of the Act, or these regulations, may be made before any member of Parliament, Justice of the Peace, solicitor, Notary Public, Registrar of a Magistrate's Court, constable, minister of religion, or member of the New Zealand Society of Accountants, or before any of the Commissioners, or any Registrar, or any Postmaster, or before any other officer of the Social Security Department or of the Post Office approved for the purpose by the Commission."
- **3.** (1) The principal regulations are hereby further amended by revoking regulation 16.
- (2) Regulation 7 of the Social Security (Monetary Benefits) Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 1, is hereby consequentially revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The effect of regulation 2 is to include among the persons who may take statutory declarations for the purposes of Part II of the principal Act and of the principal regulations members of the New Zealand Society of Accountants and approved officers of the Post Office.

Regulation 3 revokes regulation 16 of the principal regulations relating to the payment of a monetary benefit to the agent of a beneficiary. The effect of this is to leave the method of payment to the administrative discretion of the Social Security Commission.
