PURSUANT to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Secondary Schools Bursaries Regulations 1943, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Secondary Schools Bursaries Regulations 1943* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 11 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (1) the sign and figures “£40”, and substituting the sign and figures “£50”.
