HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Social Security Act, 1938, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Dental Benefits) Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Social Security (Dental Benefits) Regulations 1946* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 16 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following subclause :—

“(5) Without limiting the provisions of section 84 of the Act, it is hereby declared that any contract under this regulation may be terminated at any time by the Minister or the contracting dentist or contracting authority by giving to the other party to the contract not less than three months' notice in writing in that behalf.”
