Pursuant to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Secondary Schools Bursaries Regulations 1943, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Secondary Schools Bursaries Regulations 1943* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 7 of the principal regulations, as amended by regulation 3 of the Secondary Schools Bursaries Regulations 1943, Amendment

No. 2, is hereby further amended—

(a) By omitting from paragraph (c) the word "and":

(b) By revoking paragraph (d).
3. Paragraph (b) of regulation 3 of the Secondary Schools Bursaries Regulations 1943, Amendment No. 2, is hereby consequentially revoked.
