HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Social Security Act 1938, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Physiotherapy Benefits) Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Social Security (Physiotherapy Benefits) Regulations 1951* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. (1) Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (1), and substituting the following subclause:
- "(1) Subject to the provisions of this regulation, where any physiotherapist, being a contractor under these regulations, has, on or after the 1st day of December 1962, afforded any physiotherapy benefits to any person, otherwise than as a member of a group, in accordance with these regulations he shall be entitled to receive from the Fund a fee of 5s. for each separate occasion on which any such benefits have been afforded."
- (2) Subclause (1) of regulation 2 of the Social Security (Physiotherapy Benefits) Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 2, is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The effect of the amendment made by these regulations is that the fee which a physiotherapist may claim from the Social Security Fund is increased from 3s. 6d. to 5s. for each treatment. The increase does not apply to group treatments.
