**THE SOCIAL SCIENCE BURSARIES REGULATIONS 1966,

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Science Bursaries Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Social Science Bursaries Regulations 1966* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Value of bursary—Regulation 5 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Social Science Bursaries Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 1) is hereby further amended by omitting the expression “\$255”, and substituting the expression “\$315”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Social Science Bursaries Regulations 1966 by increasing the maximum annual value of the Social Science Bursary from \$255 to \$315.

Date of notification in *Gazette*: 6 March 1975.
