Pursuant to the Social Security Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Monetary Benefits) Regulations 1971, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Social Security (Monetary Benefits) Regulations 1971* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Change of title from Registrar to Director—Every reference in the principal regulations to the Registrar shall hereafter be read as a reference to the Director.
