HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Secondary Schools Bursaries Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Secondary Schools Bursaries Regulations 1977* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Value and term of bursary—Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (1), and substituting the following subclause:

"(1) The holder of a bursary shall be paid it in such instalments and at such times that—

(a) He receives no more than \$200 in respect of any term; and

(b) He receives no more than \$567 in respect of the year 1978."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the maximum annual value of bursaries granted under the Secondary Schools Bursaries Regulations 1977 from \$500 to \$600, as from the second term of 1978.
