PURSUANT to sections 116 and 132 of the Social Security Act 1964, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title, commencement, and application—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Dental Benefits) Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 10, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Social Security (Dental Benefits) Regulations 1983* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of August 1992, and shall apply to dental benefits provided on or after

that date. In respect of dental benefits provided before that date, the principal regulations shall continue to apply as if these regulations had not been made.

- 2. Dental benefits fees increased on and after 1 August 1992—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Social Security (Dental Benefits) Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 7), and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- (2) The Social Security (Dental Benefits) Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 7 are hereby consequentially revoked.
