**THE SHIPPING SAFETY (SMALL CRAFT) ORDER 1942,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

PURSUANT to the Shipping Safety Emergency Regulations 1940,* the Minister in Charge of the Police Department doth hereby make the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Shipping Safety (Small Craft) Order 1942, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Shipping Safety (Small Craft) Order 1942† (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

2. Clause 6 of the principal Order is hereby amended by adding the following as subclause (2) thereof :—

“(2) This clause shall apply with respect to all small craft without exception.”

3. Clause 3 of the principal Order is hereby consequentially amended by inserting at the beginning of the clause the words “Except where otherwise specially provided”.
