ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 1 (6) of the State Services Conditions of Employment Act 1977 (as substituted by section 13 (2) of the State Services Conditions of Employment Amendment Act (No. 2) 1985), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the State Services Conditions of Employment Act Commencement Order 1988.

2. Commencement of section 72 in respect of employees of Education Service—Section 72 of the State Services Conditions of Employment Act 1977, to the extent that it applies to acts or omissions of employees, shall come into force on the 23rd day of February 1988 in respect of acts and omissions of employees of the Education Service (as defined in section 2 of the State Services Conditions of Employment Act 1977).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

Section 72 of the State Services Conditions of Employment Act 1977 provides for the suspension of non-striking employees where work is not available for them during a strike. That section does not at present apply in respect of the acts or omissions of employees of any of the State services. This order brings that section into force on 23 February 1988 in respect of acts and omissions of employees of the Education Service (as defined in section 2 of the State Services Conditions of Employment Act 1977).
