Pursuant to section 4 (4) of the State Services Conditions of Employment Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the State Services Conditions of Employment Order 1978.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Children's Health Camps Board—Persons employed as paid officers or employees of the Children's Health Camps Board established by section 3 of the Children's Health Camps Act 1972 are hereby declared to be part of the State services for the purposes of the State Services Conditions of Employment Act 1977.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect. Persons employed as paid officers or employees of the Children's Health Camps Board are declared to be part of the State services for the purposes of the State Services Conditions of Employment Act 1977 so that the conditions of employment of those persons can be determined in accordance with that Act.
