ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 15th day of June 1981

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to section 4 (4) (a) of the State Services Conditions of Employment Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the State Services Conditions of Employment Order 1981.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.

2. School bus drivers—(1) Persons—

- (a) Who—
 - (i) Are employed as school bus drivers by an Education Board within the meaning of the Education Act 1964; or
 - (ii) As employees of such an Education Board, perform (whether alone or in addition to other duties as such employees) the duties of school bus drivers; and
- (b) Who perform the duties of school bus drivers for the Education Board only in their capacity as employees of the Education Board,—

are hereby declared to be part of the State services for the purposes of the State Services Conditions of Employment Act 1977.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order enables the conditions of employment of the persons described in clause 2 of this order to be determined in accordance with the State Services Conditions of Employment Act 1977.
