ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 21st day of October 1985

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 4(4)(a) of the State Services Conditions of Employment Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the State Services Conditions of Employment Order 1985.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of November 1985.

2. University staff—(1) All persons who are employed by any university within the meaning of the Universities Act 1961 as—

- (a) Caretakers or custodians; or
- (b) Assistant caretakers or assistant custodians; or
- (c) Cleaners; or
- (d) Porters or attendants; or
- (e) Car park attendants; or
- (f) Security officers,—

are hereby declared to be part of the State services for the purposes of the State Services Conditions of Employment Act 1977.

(2) This order shall have effect notwithstanding anything in the State Services Conditions of Employment Order 1983.*

3. Consequential amendments—The First Schedule to the State Services Conditions of Employment Order 1983* is hereby amended by omitting items 19, 24, 25, 26, and 32.
