EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

The effect of these regulations is to revoke the exemption from Social Security charge to which members of the armed forces are entitled in respect of their pay and allowances and of superannuation contributions paid on their behalf by their employers.
