**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

**HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to the Social Security Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title**—These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (District Nursing Services) Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Social Security (District Nursing Services) Regulations 1964\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

**2. Definition of “district nursing services” amended**—Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the words “as a nurse”, the words “community nurse,”.
