THE SOCIAL SECURITY (X-RAY DIAGNOSTIC SERVICES) REGULATIONS 1941, AMENDMENT NO. 1

At the Government House at Wellington, this 28th day of January, 1942.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Social Security Act, 1938, His Excellency the General-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (X-ray Diagnostic Services) Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Social Security (X-ray Diagnostic Services) Regulations 1941* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Clause 8 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "the photographs were taken" in subclause (2), the words "or are delivered to any other medical practitioner or Hospital Board concerned with the subsequent treatment of the patient".

3. Clause 9 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following subclause :---

"(4) Where any examination relates to part only of a region for which a fee is prescribed, the fee for the examination shall be the fee prescribed for an examination of the region. Where any part is comprised in two or more regions for which different fees are prescribed, the fee for the separate examination of that part shall be the lowest of the fees prescribed for the several regions."

4. Clause 11 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding to subclause (1) the following proviso :---

"Provided that nothing in this subclause shall apply in any case where the patient or a responsible person competent to act on behalf of the patient notifies the radiologist in writing that he does not wish to accept the benefit of the regulations, and in any such case the whole amount of the radiologist's fees may be charged to or on account of the patient, and no fees shall be payable from the Fund."

5. (1) Clause 12 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding to paragraph (a) of subclause (2) the following words :----

"and a certificate to the same effect signed by or on behalf of the patient:

"Provided that in any case where the Medical Officer of Health is satisfied that owing to special circumstances it was not practicable to obtain a certificate from or on behalf of the patient, he may dispense with the furnishing of such certificate."

(2) Clause 12 of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following subclause :---

"(4) If on being required so to do by the radiologist who has rendered any X-ray diagnostic service, the patient or any responsible person competent to act on behalf of the patient refuses to sign any certificate required by the radiologist in support of a claim for payment from the Fund, and if production of such certificate is not dispensed with by the Medical Officer of Health pursuant to the foregoing provisions of this clause, the radiologist may charge and recover the full amount of his fees from the patient or from any person responsible for his debts."

6. The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby revoked, and the following Schedule is hereby substituted therefor :---
