PURSUANT to sections 116, 123, and 132 of the Social Security Act 1964, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Laboratory Diagnostic Services) Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 12, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Social Security (Laboratory Diagnostic Services) Regulations 1981* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 26th day of September 1991, and shall apply to laboratory diagnostic services provided on or after that date. In respect of laboratory diagnostic services provided before that date, the principal regulations shall continue to apply as if these regulations had not been made.

2. New Schedule to principal regulations—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule (as substituted by regulation 3 (1) of the Social Security (Laboratory Diagnostic Services) Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 10 and amended by regulation 5 of the Social Security (Laboratory Diagnostic Services) Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 11), and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) Regulation 3 of, and the Schedule to, the Social Security (Laboratory Diagnostic Services) Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 10 are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 26 September 1991, delete the following tests: H02 Platelet count (now included in S01-Complete blood count).

BH5 and BH6 Vitamin B12 and Folic Acid-now combined in BH8.

The following tests have been deleted:

BF3 Occult blood

BG1 Glucose serum

BX1 Chorionic Gonadotrophin screen (pregnancy test)

The following test has been deleted: SO6 Urinalysis screen tests ("routine")

(a) Glucose

(b) Protein

(c) Microscopy (if indicated) (d) Bacterial culture and colony count

(e) Antimicrobial sensitivities (if indicated)

This has been replaced with-

M40 Urine culture (with colony count, identification, and sensitivities where indicated). Parts (a) and (b) of the Urinalysis screen test have been deleted.

The following test has been added to the Schedule:

D80 HIV screen test.

The new Schedule also prescribes a new scale of fees payable by the Department of Health for laboratory diagnostic services provided on or after 26 September 1991.
